By 2013 the group had enough money to purchase their current premises in Glenreagh Street – known as "Sambrook House" after the previous owners. They are "careful with money" and , although ongoing renovations have been done, they will still have cleared their mortgage later this year *[Well Done...]*. The station plays a great variety of music – much suited to "older folk" *(Who? Us?)* – and everyone was both interested in and impressed by John's talk. The usual Certificate was presented.
